Here are a few handy tips for preparing...

Relax

Chill, relax and don't worry! There will be no hurry, no stress, no spectators and no need to get it right first time. We'll shoot lots of images and allow you to see and have input in which shots are the "keepers".

Hair & Make-Up

Ahead of the shoot day, have a think about how you like your hair and make-up (if applicable!) to be and allow time perhaps to tweak things if it's windy or wet outside!

Teeth

If you're going to have a meal between leaving home and your shoot, bring a toothbrush so you can give your teeth a clean and remove any the spinach!

Outfits

Feel free to bring a change of outfits – there will be time to try a couple of different looks.

Headshots are Portraits

Remember that we are shooting you and your portrait and not a fashion model!

The difference is that you just have to be you and we want to show you as you really are. So there's no "Austin Powers" type direction, just gentle friendly encouragement and ideas to help capture the real you at your very best.
